Q: What is Kidney Failure & available treatment options?

A: Kidney failure, also called End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD), is the last stage of chronic kidney disease. Chronic kidney disease is a condition in which kidneys lose some of their abilities to remove waste products and excess fluid from the bloodstream. As waste products and fluids build up in the body, other body systems are affected, which can be harmful to your health. If your kidneys fail, you will need dialysis or a kidney transplant to survive.

Q: Which treatment option is better and why?

A: Kidney transplantation is considered the treatment of choice for many people with severe chronic kidney disease because quality of life and survival (life expectancy) are often better than people who are treated with dialysis. Kidney Transplant is more economic and cheaper modality of treatment in long term as compared to hemodialysis. Moreover, in children kidney transplant is the only way out for a normal growth.

Q: Shifa started its Kidney Transplant program in year 2001. Please elaborate the salient features of the program.

A: Our program includes specialists from various departments and since 2000 we have performed more than 500 kidney transplants at the facility. The stringent infection control practices, immunosuppressive protocols and proactive vigil for complications and their prompt management make the service a huge success.

We are the pioneers for doing minimally invasive donor surgeries. Our pre-transplant immunological workup is very extensive and at par with the international standards. We have a professional and team based approach which allows us to review each case thoroughly in pre-transplant meeting.

Q: Which healthcare professionals are part of the multidisciplinary teams involved in Pre and Post Op. care of Kidney Transplant recipients and donors?

The team includes, transplant surgeon, transplant nephrologist, immunologist, histopathologist, cardiologist, pulmonologist, psychiatrist, infectious disease specialist, anesthesiologist and donor advocate. Our team also has a good liaison with our professional colleagues from other medical and surgical specialties and they are deeply involved whenever they are needed especially from radiology, endocrinology and gastroenterology.

Q: Any advice for kidney transplant recipients and donors?

Advice to donors would be that they should avoid gaining weight after donation and monitor their blood sugar and blood pressure levels. An ultrasound of kidneys is also recommended annually. They should not misuse medication especially like NSAIDS etc.

For recipients, they should be compliant with medications and followup visits and need to act upon all the precautions as advised by the transplant team.
