Inister of State for Climate Change; Ms. Zartaj Gul Wazir, while addressing an awareness seminar at Shifa International Hospital Islamabad on World Cancer Day (4th Feb 2020) as a Chief Guest emphasized the need for mass health awareness to educate communities on risk factors and causes related to cancer. She particularly addressed Pakistani youth to play their part in national awareness to sensitize general public on protecting and safeguarding our environment & climate to nurture a cleaner and greener Pakistan.

Mr. Aamir Zulfiqar Khan (Inspector General Police, Islamabad), was invited as Guest of Honor for the seminar. Mr. Khan urged that awareness is the first step towards prevention, timely detection and eventually successfully treating cancer and pledged all-out support for mass community health awareness for the residents of Islamabad.

Dr. M. Furrukh (Consultant Radiation Oncologist, SIH) while addressing the occasion said that, more than one-third of cancer cases can be prevented. Another one-third can be cured if detected early and treated properly. He educated the audience about seven warning signs of cancer, i.e., changes in bathroom habits, a sore that does not heal, unusual discharge and bleeding from natural orifices, thickness or lumps in the breast or other parts, indigestion and difficulty in swallowing, obvious changes in moles or warts, nagging cough and hoarseness, etc. and emphasized to timely get doctor's advice.



Dr. Ayaz Mir (Consultant Medical Oncologist, SIH) shared that taking simple actions such as stopping smoking, avoiding use of alcohol, exercising regularly, maintaining vitamins especially D level in the body and reducing the intake of white sugar, junk food, processed and red meat can extend a healthy life, and it would prove to be the first-line of defense against cancer and other associated noncommunicable diseases.

Dr. Manzoor H. Qazi (CEO, SIH), Dr. Zeeshan Bin Inshtique (Medical Director, SIH) and Mr. Taimoor Shah (COO, SIH) emphasized the need to implement a holistic strategy to collectively fight cancer epidemic through health awareness and education. International Epilepsy Day: Shifa International Hospital Pledges to Underline Epilepsy Treatment and Prevention

International Epilepsy Day was marked to raise awareness of epilepsy; what it is? how it can be treated?, and what is needed to bring treatment to all people who need it? According to World Health Organization (WHO), around 50 million people worldwide have epilepsy, making it one of the most common neurological diseases globally. Shifa International Hospital vows to emphasize Epilepsy Awareness, Prevalence, Treatment & its Prevention.



Overall prevalence of Epilepsy in Pakistan is estimated to be 9.99 per 1000 population:

Dr. Maimoona Siddiqui, (HOD & Consultant Neurologist, Shifa International Hospital) said that, traditionally, the diagnosis of epilepsy requires the occurrence of at least 2 unprovoked seizures. The first seizure should not be treated unless there are any clinical findings explained on diagnostic tests including MRI, EEG or any abnormal focal neurological findings or in case of family history. The lifetime likelihood of experiencing at least 1 epileptic seizure is about 9%, and the lifetime likelihood of receiving a diagnosis of epilepsy is almost 3%. According to a study, overall prevalence of epilepsy in Pakistan is estimated to be 9.99 per 1000 population, which is more or less similar to Global Prevalence (5-10 cases per 1000). It is estimated that up to 70% of people living with epilepsy could live seizure-free if properly diagnosed and treated. As per the recommendations of Epilepsy Foundation, Dr. Maimoona advised about precautionary steps that should be taken to avoid epilepsy related accidents. These include replacing glass utensils with plastic, use caution with hot fluids, take shower instead of bath, install a rubber mat or nonskid strips on the tub or shower floor, pad hard edges of tables and furniture, cook with partner, consider using a seizure alert monitor or sharing a room. According to Dr. Azhar Saeed (Consultant Neurologist, SIH), although the mainstay of treatment for individuals with epilepsy is pharmacological, non-drug treatments such as psychological interventions, the Ketogenic Diet (KD) and Vagus Nerve Stimulation (VNS) are also used.
