Radiation Oncology & Bone Marrow
Transplant teams at Shifa International
Hospital, Islamabad has successfully
performed the first Total Body Irradiation (TBI)
of a patient suffering from Acute Lymphatic
Leukemia (ALL). Total Body Irradiation was
recently added to Shifa's arsenal for treating
cancer. Only available at a few centers in the
region, this modality is particularly of use in
bone marrow/ stem cell transplant for
diseases like Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia
and half-matched (Haplo) transplant. It also
provides a less toxic option for transplants in the
elder population when used at a lower dose. Dr. Ayaz Mir,
Chief of Bone Marrow Transplant Unit stated that the procedure was

made successful by a multidisciplinary team of Oncologists, Radiation Oncologists, Medical Physicists and a dedicated nursing team catering to patients' need. Dr. M. Furrukh, Consultant Radiation Oncologist said that this advanced technology will play a key role in the treatment of cancer diseases in-country as many patients who were unable to get this treatment here had to travel many miles abroad. Shifa International Hospital is committed in its endeavors to provide the people of Pakistan with the most advanced healthcare and will continue to do so.





#### SIH Introduces MRI Breast on SIEMENS 3Tesla MAGNETOM VIDA SCANNER

he Radiology Department at Shifa International Hospital is proud to announce and introduce its state-of-the-art high magnet strength 3T MRI (SIEMENS MAGNETOM VIDA) machine which is top of the line by all international standards, resulting in better imaging techniques and precision imaging.

We have started MRI Breast with our 18 channel breast coil, which in conjunction with higher strength magnet, resulting a reduction in overall scan time with high resolution of images increasing the diagnostic yield.

MRI Breast is one of the key imaging techniques in the treatment of breast cancer along with Mammography & Sono Mammography. This technology is used as a problem-solving tool for screening the true extent of cancer in the malignant breast and also it plays a key role in patients who are on neo-adjuvant chemotherapy before their surgery and in screening of women with high risk of cancer given its higher sensitivity. Furthermore, this technology guides our aesthetic specialists to spot any rupture in breast implants.

On the occasion, Dr. Ejaz said that "Antibiotic or Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) has been called one of the 'greatest threats' to human health with significant public health consequences unless we all come together and work to save remaining antibiotics. Overuse of antibiotics in humans and animal causes AMR that is now a major public health crisis." He said that by reducing the spread of infections and changing how we produce, prescribe, and use these medicines, we can reduce the impact and limit the spread of antibiotic resistance.
