

ceremony was recently arranged to commemorate the completion of over 300 Bone Marrow/ Stem Cell Transplants at A Shifa International Hospital Islamabad. Dr. Ayaz Mir along with the core BMT team members; Maj. Dr. Manzoor H. Qazi, Chief Executive Officer, congratulated consultants, nursing, medical & paramedical teams, technical and support teams on completion of over 300 BMT transplants with excellent results with a success rate comparable to International Standards.


### Webinar on Pediatric Dermatology in ER
