

GLIMPSES OF WORLD PATIENT SAFETY DAY SEMINAR AT SHIFA INTERNATIONAL HOSPITAL

An awareness seminar in lieu of World Patient Safety Day was arranged at Shifa Int. Hospital Islamabad on 17th Sep 2021. Dr. Nausheen Hamid (Parliamentary Secretary of Health, NHSR & C) was the Chief Guest and Dr. Quaid Saeed Akhunzada (CEO, Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority) was the Guest of Honor for the occasion. Speaking on the occasion, the honorable Chief Guest Dr. Nausheen Hamid, lauded the efforts by the management of Shifa for raising awareness on this sensitive issue and practicing and adhering to patient safety standards. She said that hospitals should ensure the safety of patients as it is a huge challenge in the health sector and its importance has greatly increased during the continuing challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. She also gave an overview of the initiatives taken by the government for capacity building and training of healthcare workers for patient safety in the public health sector. Guest of Honor, Dr. Quaid Saeed Akhunzada with particular reference to WHO theme of the year; "Safe Maternal & Newborn Care" elaborated the central role of mothers in a family unit and paid tribute to all mothers for their sacrifices and contribution from childbirth to nurturing a healthy next generation. He highlighted the need for public and private partnerships for capacity building to train a broader healthcare workforce at a regional level.

Mr. Taimoor Shah also took an oath from Patient Safety Champions (cross-functional teams) and later acknowledgment certificates were distributed among the participants.
