Consultants of Shifa delivered lectures on the management and prevention of diabetes. Dr. Matti Ullah Khan, an associate consultant endocrinologist, said on this occasion that more people are required to be educated which are at high risk of having diabetes due to unhealthy lifestyles, lack of exercise & a high consumption of sugary items. Dr. Saba Hafeez, an associate consultant endocrinologist, said that diabetes is a disease that occurs when the blood glucose is too high. She said that 90% of the population with diabetes has type 2 diabetes. She recommended that people should consume a healthy diet, do regular exercises, and walk for at least 30 minutes a day to stay healthy.

he purpose of the Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease (COPD) Symposium was to enlighten healthcare professionals about the importance of COPD. Dr. Jawad Khaliq Ansari, President Pakistan Chest Society was the chief guest. SHIFA SUCCESSFULLY CONCLUDES THE FIRST-EVER SARS-COV-2 VACCINE TRIAL (PHASE III) IN PAKISTAN

Shifa International Hospital successfully concluded the first-ever SARS-CoV-2 vaccine trial (Phase III), in Pakistan to defeat COVID-19. It lasted more than 2 years & recruited more than 17,000 volunteers from five major institutions in Pakistan. Globally more than 44,000 volunteers were recruited. At Shifa more than 5,480 volunteers participated and contributed to a major portion of the data for this trial. Professor Dr. Ejaz Khan, the principal investigator of this trial at Shifa International Hospital briefed the audience at the closing ceremony about the journey, benefits, and outcomes of the trial. He termed the trial one of its kind with a single-dose vaccine against COVID-19 and a success because only after 5 months the vaccine was approved by DRAP and made available for the public in Pakistan which helped in saving thousands of lives. He said Pakistan soon started its production at the National Institute of Health by the name of PakVac and that it was available for distribution as well. Dr. Manzoor Hul Haq Qazi, Chief Executive Officer, SIH lauded the effort of the research team that had successfully conducted the vaccine trials in the Shifa.



SHIFA INTERNATIONAL HOSPITAL OBSERVES WORLD PREMATURITY DAY

Shifa International Hospital observed World Prematurity Day to raise awareness about premature birth and its effects. Pakistan has critical need for neonatal critical care facilities as prematurity is one of the leading cause of death in children under the age of 5 in Pakistan.
