SHIFA'S REHABILITATION DEPARTMENT ORGANIZES THE **1ST LOCAL PEDIATRIC DYSPHAGIA SUPPORT GROUP**

he activity was organized to provide a safe and supportive space for parents and caregivers of children with dysphagia. The goal of the group was to connect, share resources, and find encouragement.

Statistics indicate that approximately 10.5% of premature infants born before 37 weeks gestation have swallowing difficulties. Shifa International Hospital offers neonatal dysphagia screening and management services, with qualified speech pathologists and therapists available for assessment and management of swallowing difficulties in inpatient, outpatient, and home health settings. Early detection of dysphagia, evidence-based intervention, and rehabilitation are key to speedy recovery.

During the session, Mr. Kashif Khan, AGM Rehab helped parents understand appropriate feeding posture to ensure safety for children with compromised swallow mechanisms. Ms. Faiza Badar, Speech Pathologist, and Manager of Rehab, moderated the session. Parents were encouraged to share their challenges and success stories to motivate others.

Ms. Mahwish Zafar, Head Practitioner Speech Therapist, spoke about the red flags, signs of aspiration, and malnutrition in premature children, and shared different activities to make

mealtimes more pleasant for the pediatric population. Ms. Saima Kanwal, Senior Occupational Therapist, addressed participants' queries related to sensory issues resulting in feeding problems. Dr. Yasser Masood, Consultant Pediatrician, and Neonatologist, also joined the session and debunked existing myths about dysphagia management in society, highlighting the importance of speech therapy in managing pediatric dysphagia.

alwa Ahsan, Chief of Pharmacy at Shifa International Hospital & Senior VP, of the Pakistan Society of Health-System Pharmacists (PSHP) played a key role in launching a patient safety project along with the Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) aimed at improving the safety of High-Alert Medicines.

High Alert Medicines (HAMs) are known for serious, life-threatening consequences when used in error. The Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) launched the collaborative project for patient safety with the Pakistan Society of Health-System Pharmacists (PSHP), and United States Pharmacopeia (USP) to prevent loss of life due to medication errors involving

High-Alert Medicines. Senior members of the partner organizations met with Dr. Quaid Saeed, CEO of the Islamabad Healthcare Regulatory Authority (IHRA) to launch this initiative.

Salwa Ahsan Senior VP of PSHP and Chief of Pharmacy at Shifa International Hospital is coordinating with IHRA & USP Pakistan to launch a pilot project in ICT in this regard. Shifa International Hospitals Ltd. is a Joint Commission International-accredited healthcare facility that shall be acting as a role model and training site in this project. In this regard, Shifa International Hospitals Ltd. has already facilitated a one-day training for the IHRA surveyors on the HAMs guidelines, safety standards, and monitoring parameters in the first phase.

In the wake of high energy prices and commitment towards a sustainable environment, Shifa is proud to announce the installation of its state-of-the-art 900kWp DC solar power system.

With this system, the power of the sun will be harnessed to provide clean, renewable energy to the facility. This not only helps to reduce the reliance on traditional energy sources but also helps to lower operational costs.

Shifa's solar power system also supports its commitment to sustainability and the environment. By reducing carbon emissions, Shifa is contributing to creating a healthier planet for our patients and their families.

The system has resulted to be much-needed support to the existing power network previously having peak summer demand of 3.5MW out of which 0.8MW will be compensated by solar power.

The system will be delivering approximately 1.2 Million Units per Annum to the hospital and is just one of the many ways the hospital is working to provide the best possible care to our patients while also making a positive impact on the world around us.
