#### ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT PNEUMONIA

#### What is Pneumonia?

Pneumonia is an infection of the lungs. The infection is usually caused by bacteria or a virus.

The infection causes inflammation (swelling) in your lungs. The air sacs in your lungs can fill up with fluid, making it harder for you to breathe.

#### What are the symptoms of Pneumonia?

The symptoms of Pneumonia depend on age, type of organism and any existing immune system problems you may have. The most common symptoms of Pneumonia are:

- Fever: A temperature of 38 degree or higher
- Cough: Which can be dry or may produce thick mucus
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- Rapid breathing
- Feeling generally tired and unwell
- Loss of appetite

#### What causes Pneumonia?

Pneumonia is caused by an infection of the lungs. Most infections are caused by bacteria or viruses. Pneumonia can be triggered by a cold or the flu, which allows the germs to access to your lungs.

#### **Bacterial Pneumonia**

- Bacterial Pneumonia is commonly caused by the pneumococcal bacteria, called Streptococcus Pneumonia.
- This is one of the common and severe types of Pneumonia.

#### Viral Pneumonia

- Viral Pneumonia is caused by different viruses. The most commonare:
- Influenza (flu) virus
- Respiratory syncytial virus
- SARS-CoV-2 (The virus that causes COVID-19)

#### How is Pneumonia diagnosed?

Doctors diagnose pneumonia mainly by symptoms you have and by examining you.

Tests for Pneumonia include:

- Blood tests
- A chest x-ray

#### How is Pneumonia treated?

Treatment will depend on your age and the type of pneumonia you have.

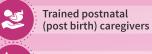
If bacteria have caused your infection, the main treatment is antibiotics. Antibiotics are medicines that kill bacteria. Viral Pneumonia cannot be treated with antibiotics. In most cases, viral Pneumonia needs only supportive care and will clear up by itself.

#### Can Pneumonia be prevented?

Prevention is the best protection from pneumonia. Avoiding crowded places, wearing masks, adhering to cough etiquettes and Vaccinations (such as Pneumococcal and influenza vaccines) can help prevent some types of Pneumonia.





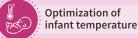






















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
