

Shifa Teams Up with Fleming Fund to Combat Antimicrobial Resistance & Setting up Antibiotic Stewardship Program









Shifa International Hospital and Fleming Fund UK has mutually agreed to enter into a formal memorandum of understanding active desired. enter into a formal memorandum of understanding aimed at strengthening and enhancing antibiotic stewardship program (ASP) to combat Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR). The Fleming Fund UK stands as a beacon in the global fight against AMR named in honor of Sir Alexander Fleming, the pioneering scientist who discovered 'Penicillin'. Established by the UK government, the fund is dedicated to supporting low- and middle-income countries in strengthening their capacity to tackle AMR. Shifa's Antibiotic Stewardship team including physicians, nurses, microbiologists and pharmacists under leadership of Dr. Ejaz Khan, Consultant ID physician and Chair Antibiotic Stewardship Subcommittee ASSC, Shifa International Hospital and Ms. Salwa Ahsan, Chief of Pharmacy, Member ASSC, Shifa International Hospital is developing a comprehensive training program on antibiotic stewardship to realize this aim. Through this program, healthcare professionals from Shifa as well as from other healthcare institutes will receive specialized training in this domain, equipping them with the necessary knowledge and skills to implement the antibiotic stewardship program. Dr. Ejaz Khan said on the occasion that "Together, we are aiming to embark on a journey to not only converting Shifa's antibiotic stewardship program (ASP) as the Center of Excellence in the region, but also replicating the similar model in other hospitals around the country".

Ms. Salwa Ahsan stated that "This alliance not only has the potential to serve as a great capacity building model, setting new standards in antibiotic stewardship and AMR mitigation within the hospital, but also across the broader healthcare ecosystem of Pakistan."
